
The paper will be grade-specific and will consist of 30 questions to be solved in 3 hours. It will be conducted in the school on 6<sup>th</sup> May, 2017 (Saturday).

The paper will be developed, printed and assessed by a team of educators and researchers of CIC, Delhi University. A minimal fee of Rs. 100/- has to be paid for appearing in the exam. Each student, who appears for SMAT, will receive a certificate.

We would like each student of Class VI, VII and VIII to appear for SMAT and experience the thrill of success while revisiting important Science and Mathematical concepts.
