This is in reference to the rising incidents of **dengue and chikungunya** fever in the city. The school is taking requisite measures such as **fumigation & maintenance of hygiene** in the school premises. To prevent breeding of its vector i.e. the mosquito in and around the school, an intensive **public awareness campaign** was also launched to educate the students as well as masses about the common mosquito breeding apparatus & its prevention.

You are also requested to send your ward in **full sleeve white shirts & blue/black trousers/plain jeans (in place of shorts/tunic)**. In addition, other measures such as use of mosquito repellents/bands may also be undertaken.

**Kindly refrain from sending your ward to school if suffering from fever, as viral infection is highly contagious.**

ALSO SUBMIT **A LEAVE-APPLICATION AND A MEDICAL REPORT** AT THE RECEPTION IMMEDIATELY.

Please report to the school medical officer in the event of dengue & chikungunya, especially when your ward returns to school after recovery, so that he/she may be given due care & attention.

I am sure that with resolute efforts, we shall be able to overcome this challenge and keep our children safe and disease free.
