General Instructions:

- The project should include the following:
 - a) The cover page should have the project title, the student's information, the school's name and the academic year.
 - b) Index: a list of contents with the page numbers.
 - c) Acknowledgements (acknowledging the institutions and persons who have helped)

Tips for the students:

- Read books (Be it fables, fairy tales, comic books, novels, autobiographies or encyclopedia). Be imaginative and go on a fantasy tour.
- Run exercise, sweat! Channel your energy and enjoy playing indoor/outdoor games.
- Enhance your communication skills by conversing with your friends and family in English.
- Explore the culture and heritage of the world by visiting the heritage sites virtually.
- Download the app '**Google Earth**' and enjoy virtual tours around the world. Plan a family picnic to '**Waste to Wonder park**' (Sarai Kale Khan) or the newly opened '**Bharat Darshan park** (Punjabi Bagh) and experience how waste can be converted into wonder!
- Prepare well for Periodic Test-I, to be held in July 2022.
