The summer vacation are around the corner and it is a period where you can spend quality time with your child and ensure their learning.

Here are a few tips and ideas to cultivate a love for reading at home.

- Let your child hold the book as you read.
- Allow her/him to touch the pages.
- Invite her/him to read with you.
- Encourage her/him to read the pictures and talk about them.
- Designate a “reading time” where the whole family sits down to read.
- Allow her/him to choose books.

Please send the following material in a well-labeled folder on the first day when the school reopens after the summer break.

1. Rhyming words flip book

- Take an A-4 sized sheet.
- Divide it into three parts.
- The first part consists of flipping pages with consonants written on each sheet.
- The middle part consists of any one rhyming words family, like ap/eg/it/on/un.
- The third part consists of only meaningful pictures

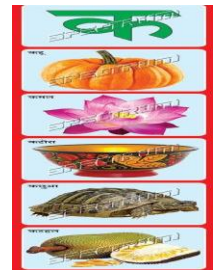
Please send this homework well-labeled and spiral-bound.



2. Make a picture dictionary

- Take a scrap file.
- On each page, write a वर्ण and paste pictures of related vocabulary words. (क - ह)

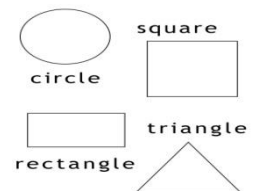
Scrap file should be well-labeled, covered properly and decorated.



3. Shape cutouts

- Make different shapes (triangle, square, rectangle, and circle) using a cardboard.
- They can be of different sizes and colours.
- Laminate each of them with a broad tape.

Send them in a beautifully covered box.



4. Make your own Table mat and Apron

Table Mat

- On an A-4 size sheet or cloth, paste your child's photograph on the corner.
- Let your child make any picture through vegetable printing.
- Laminate the same.



Apron

- Follow the image for making an apron using cloth according to your ward's size.
- Make your ward do finger/thumb printing on the same using fabric colours.
- Laminate and label it.
