OUTSTANDING RESULTS : We are elated to inform you that our students have once again excelled in CBSE X & XII Board Examinations. The results have been **OUTSTANDING with 100% pass percentage** and highest score touching 97%. A **Result Special Bulletin** will reach you soon to inform you about our glorious toppers and sky-scraping marks.

PARENT TEACHER MEETING : The school is holding **PTM on August 01, 2015 (8.15 am – 10.45 am)** instead of July 25, due to AIPMT Re-Exam in the school.

UNIT TEST II : Unit Test II (V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X & XII) and Unit Test I for Class XI begins on **July 20, 2015 (weekly)**. The Date-sheet and Syllabus has been distributed among the students. Students are requested to study wholeheartedly and sincerely, as every Unit Test holds a huge chunk of weightage.

ATTENDANCE IS COMPULSORY during the exam days.

HOLIDAYS' HOMEWORK : The last date for submission of Holidays' Homework Project is 10th July, 2015 (Friday). **Marks credited to Holidays Homework will be added to the Final Report Card.**

HEALTH SERVICES : This is to inform you that the school is sincerely concerned about the physical, emotional and mental well-being of the students.

1. Hence, we have appointed a **professionally qualified counsellor**, with whom you can discuss academic, behavioural and emotional issues concerning your ward.

You can meet Ms. Divya Chawla, School Counsellor at the Senior Branch between **8.00 am to 9.30 am** on all working days with prior appointment. **The school reception may be contacted to fix up an appointment.**

2. Also, the students are now covered under the Medical Insurance Scheme of TATA AIG General Insurance Company Ltd. As per policy agreement, you will be entitled to a reimbursement of medical expenses pertaining to accidental injury. However, 10% of the same will be charged as processing fee and hence deducted from the final amount. On a minimal payment of Rs. 150/- per student per annum, one can avail a reimbursement of up to Rs. 5000/-

All other medical expenses apart from those caused by accident/injury are excluded under the policy. These expenses will be borne by the parents themselves.

Therefore, in case of accident/trauma, you may submit the requisite documents to Dr. Anshu Asri, Medical Officer, for verification and processing.

However, the whole procedure might take some time. Kindly, bear with us for the processing time.
