- **Formative Assessment includes continuous assessment on the basis of unit test, class response, activities, oral tests, notebook maintenance and day-to-day participation in the classroom teaching-learning process.**

Hence, the students must be present and updated throughout the session.

- **Unit Test-I has begun on May 05, 2015. It is compulsory for all the students to appear in all the examinations.**
- **Please note that NO WEIGHTAGE will be given in case of absenteeism.**

- **During exam days,**
 - If a student is absent on medical grounds, a medical certificate duly signed by the doctor, and an application duly signed by the parents must be submitted on or before the day of examination.
 - If there is any other very-very urgent, unavoidable reason, due to which the student cannot take the exam, an application, duly signed by the parents must be submitted, in person, to Ms. Anvita Wahi (Senior School) & Ms. Kiran Jawa (Junior Wing), Supervisory Heads, on or before the same day.
 - **PLEASE NOTE THAT IT IS UP TO THE DISCRETION OF THE SCHOOL AUTHORITIES TO SANCTION/NOT SANCTION THE LEAVE.**
 - If the medical certificate/sanctioned application is submitted, the student will be eligible for retest, **otherwise zero (0) will be awarded.**
 - If the student is absent on the day of retest, another retest will **NOT** be given. In that case, zero will be awarded.
 - Hence, parents must ensure that the students do not miss any exam, at any cost.
- Please be informed that in Classes VIII, IX & X, minimum 25% marks are required in SA I & SA II separately, to pass the examination in the Finals. Only passing the Final (SA II) exam is not enough. Students have to pass both the examinations separately.
- Printed Academic Plans will be given to the students. They include term-wise break-up of syllabus, Formative and Summative Assessment schedule, Examination Date-sheets etc. You are requested to refer to it from time-to-time. Any unforeseen changes will be notified, if required.

The school will reopen on 1st July, 2015.


During the holidays, students are advised to :
