Please note the latest CBSE & DAVCMC examination guidelines for the students of Class VIII, IX & X as per circular No. COORD/EC-14.1.13/2014 dated 1.05.2014 & CAE/14-15/109 dated 25.07.2014.

- Please note that to qualify the examination, the students must obtain:
 - At least 25% marks in Summative Assessments (both SA 1 & SA 2 taken together) i.e. 15 out of 60 marks.
 - And **total 33% in each of the five subjects** of scholastic area.
 - And pass in all the co-scholastic areas too.
- Attendance is mandatory in SA I Examination. However, in case of any extreme illness, if a candidate is not able to appear in the exam, he/she must submit duly signed application & medical certificate before or on the day of the exam. Late applications will not be considered.
- However, any unnecessary leave should be avoided at any cost.
- The absentees will be given only <u>ONE MORE</u> CHANCE to appear for the exam within one month of the SA I Exam.
- If the candidate does not appear in this re-test, '0' (zero) will be awarded to the student, as per CBSE guidelines. After that, no student will be allowed to appear for the exam at all.
