**HALF YEARLY EXAMINATION CIRCULAR**

Dear Parents/Students

This is to bring to your notice that Half Yearly Examination for all classes will begin from First week of September, 2023. However, exams for Minor subjects will be held in last week of August. Syllabus and the Tentative datesheet for the same will be shared soon.

Please note that there will be exams of minor subjects -GK, Moral Education and Art & Craft for classes V to VIII. And for classes IX to XII we will have GK Exam, apart from other subjects.

Please note few important points related to Half Yearly Examination (Term I):

- Question Papers of Half Yearly Examination for classes V to X will be standardized and uniformly administered for all DAV Schools at the cluster level. In other words, Question Papers will be set by external team of teachers, as deputed by DAV CAE. Hence, students need to study well and prepare for the exams with utmost sincerity.
- Common Question Papers will also be administered for all main subjects for Classes V to X in Annual Examination 2024.
- Question Papers for all the classes will include COMPETENCY-BASED QUESTIONS. Hence, thorough preparation and practice required. Only last few days study will not suffice to score well in exams.
- It is MANDATORY to give Half Yearly Exams as the score in these exams will be considered for Annual Cumulative Result. However, in case of medical emergencies, parents are requested to submit Leave Application and Medical Certificate to Class Teacher. Only sending of whatsapp messages will not suffice.
- Students MUST be present in the school as Syllabus is running in full swing. Absenteeism on pretext of any issues such as functions, out of station trips etc should be avoided.
- Students MUST COMPLETE & SUBMIT their notebooks, projects, activities work etc., as allotted by Subject Teachers, as INTERNAL ASSESSMENT MARKS will be included in Half Yearly (Term I Result).
- Reinforcing that it is mandatory to score passing marks in Internal Assessment/Practical as well as Theory Examination to clear the exams.
